## Correspondence Courses

Happy New Year! Congratulations to Sue Rous and Pat Warren for completing their Spirit of Jean Correspondence Course and sending it in for critique. Kathy Rees has the pieces and we will get them back as soon as she completes the evaluation. Also, congratulations to Cindy Underwood and everyone else that completed the piece but did not submit it for evaluation.

At the December meeting, the current Correspondence Courses were presented for feedback. There was very little feedback but one of the courses that had some interest was "I Can Do It...A Simple Approach to Design Theory and Creativity". This will be the next course offered through Chicago ANG.

The Course Description reads as follows:

"Do you want to create your own petite stocking or other shaped ornament? It isn't difficult! You will learn to combine stitch patterns to create your own 'personally designed' ornament. The I Can Do It workbook by Pat Mazu will provide a simplified course in design and color theory, ideas for designs, outlines of shapes for ornaments, and composite stitch diagrams. Dozens of color images of models and stitch-combination diagrams are provided. An extensive bibliography is included. An optional kit includes #14 or #18 canvas, a selection of threads, metallic braids and beads so that you can create your first ornament."

The pricing schedule has changed. It is now \$90 for a group registration and \$30 per student teaching fee. In order to make the course cost effective, we need 5 people to sign up for the course. With 5 people, the cost for the registration fee would be \$18 (\$90 divided by 5) and the cost for the teaching fee would be \$30 making the cost per student \$48. If there are more than 5 registrants, the cost of the registration fee goes down. For this course, the text can be downloaded for free or there is a \$35 fee for a color printout plus shipping which is to be determined. The optional kit mentioned in the description is an additional \$25.00 plus shipping which is to be determined. Under the new pricing, the course evaluation fee is optional. If you choose to have your work evaluated, there would be a fee of \$25.00 plus shipping which is to be determined to and from the instructor. The deposit for holding your place in the course will be \$40 with the balance due in March prior to the submission of group registration.

If you are interested in the course, please fill out the form in the back of the newsletter and either send it to me or bring to the January, February or March meeting. The deadline for registration will be the March meeting. Please let me know if you have any questions. Keep on stitching!

## Workshops

Time for relaxing winter stitching. We need a great snowfall that keeps us inside for a few days! Our winter and spring line up has changed. Tony Minieri had back surgery in late December and his travel is going to be restricted for several months. He has a wonderful 2-day class that we saw a year ago called Austin Patch. We are going to see if there is interest in this workshop for May because we do need to cancel the Back to Basics workshops. We also have Jennifer Riefenberg joining us in May for our last vegetable piece, Beets. We always work hard to make sure our mix of workshops includes a range of kit costs and a mix of new and existing teachers. As always please let us know if you would like to see a certain piece or teacher for one of our workshops, we are always looking for new ideas. Deb Forney was fabulous this fall.

**A quick reminder about workshop policies:** if you sign up for a workshop, you must attend at least one full day of the workshop. On occasion, the designer may specify that attendance both days is required. If the workshop is a pilot class you must attend both days. Please be sure to check your schedule before signing up for a workshop to ensure you will be able to attend. Once you have been included in a workshop's final count, the \$25.00 workshop deposit is non-refundable unless your spot is filled from a workshop waiting list.

All sign-ups must be by mail, sent to Pat Warren 10817 Martindale Drive Westchester, IL 60154-5020 and be accompanied by a \$25.00 deposit. A date, on or before which the workshop coupon may be mailed and considered as a first day registration is indicated on every coupon and published in this newsletter.

**Every coupon (with deposit) post-marked on or before the designated first day date will be considered a first day member registration.** The deadline date to register will also be shown on the coupon and published in the newsletter. Workshops that have not filled will be open to non-members after this deadline date. Non-members will be asked to pay a \$30.00 non-member fee in addition to the workshop cost.

The cost of our workshops includes many things. First there is the kit fee for the class that is really determined by the size of the piece and the number and type of threads. There is a large range in these costs from \$90.00 all the way up to \$220.00. We try to offer workshops with a variety of kit fees each year. Other costs include the instructor's teaching fee for two days, the instructor's travel costs which generally includes airfare and ground transportation to their home airport, the instructor's room and board for the weekend, if applicable and the Park District room rental fee. We know that workshop prices have increased over the

years and we do our best to minimize all costs so workshops remain affordable for the guild.

Keep in mind that you can sign up for any open workshop shown below as soon as you receive this newsletter. If you are going to wait and sign up later make sure you keep in mind the deadline date.

### **Possibly May 20& 21, 2017 Austin Patch by Tony Minieri**

Tony is a long standing favorite of Chicago ANG with amazing pieces and teaching credentials. As an internationally-known needlepoint teacher with Level I Certification from The National Academy of NeedleArts, Tony instructs for the American Needlepoint Guild, Inc., The Embroiders' Guild of America, The National NeedleArts Association, needlepoint shops, guilds, and private groups. His body of work encompasses teaching and designing, and he is in much demand for creating stitch and thread guides and for teaching his project classes.

Austin Patch is a 12 x 12 design on 18 count. Four color options are available: Brushfire on Black (pictured), Field of Bluebonnets on French Blue, Winterbrook on Santa Fe Sage and Fall Foliage on Sandstone. It is a beautiful piece. Please see our web site to really view the piece. We will only schedule this class if there is sufficient interest. Pat will be checking with people. Refunds will be made for Back to Basics deposits.

### May 6 & 7, 2017: Beets by Jennifer Riefenberg

Jennifer Riefenberg is a Certified Teacher from the National Academy of Needlearts (NAN). She has taught many programs for ANG and EGA and teaches classes at TACTile, the Textile Arts Center. Chicago ANG is excited to welcome Jennifer back to teach this wonderful piece that is also being taught at Seminar in New Orleans.

*Beets* charm and glow with the warm violet red against the vibrant earth. *Beets* is the third, and final, in a series of root vegetables emerging in bright, warm colors from the summer earth; following *Carrots* and *Radishes*. *Beets* adds another dimensional feature to the series with needlelace techniques for the beet tops. Continue lessons in working with color started in *Carrots* and moving around the color wheel as your garden grows. Another vegetable emerges from your garden - this time, it is *Beets*.

**Proficiency Level:** Intermediate

**Design Size:** 5" x 7", working size of the project is ~10" x 12"

**Kit Cost/Contents:** ~\$90, line drawn canvas, all threads and beads for the project
